


Free horse property management courses, Moruya

Saturday, 5 November and Sunday, 6 November 2016

When:	Introduction to horse property management Saturday, 5 November 2016 9.30 am to 3.30 pm, lunch provided Stuart Myers from "equiculture" will be conducting courses on how to improve horse property management. The seminars will assist horse property owners to develop a sustainable equine property. During the seminars horse owners learn how to use their horses natural and domesticated behaviours combined with good pasture management principals to improve and maintain their properties, including: • how to manage pasture for horses and encourage biodiversity • the relationship between horses and their pastures including issues such as laminitis and equine obesity • how to manage manure, water and vegetation • how to plan and design a horse property.
	Other topics will include the value of sound property management practices, not only in terms of horse care, horse health, financial benefits and property aesthetic improvements, and just as importantly the environmental benefits, including the effects on water catchment, weed control and erosion and the benefits to the wider community.

From Sydney (Princes Highway)

Moruya is located 300km from Sydney along the Princes Highway

- Take the Princes Highway thru Batemans Bay and Mogo.
- 10 mins after Mogo and before Moruya turn right off highway onto Larry's Mountain Road.
- Continue for approximately 2km then turn left onto Hawdons Road.
- There is a Mogendoura Farm sign on the post.
- After approximately 1km the road turns to unsealed, travel 1km unsealed to farm entrance on the left at the bottom of the dip.
- Welcome to Mogendoura Farm.
